ABOUT THE PIECE


"Paesaggi Sonor/1/" is a composition for 3 performers created by INPUT/3/.

Having John Cage's "Imaginary Landscape n. 1" as a starting point, we have developed a 40 minutes live set that involves the essence of what an imaginary and futuristic landscape is, turned into the nowadays concept of musical scene through a multimedia language.

Analog and electronic tools are used in the piece; the performers will play with live video, feedbacks and daily life used objects.

The performers will interact actively with sounds and videos, creating a virtual/futuristic world that blends with the perception of which things are real and which are not.

Through using feedbacks apparently uncontrolled, the idea is to create a parallelism about what the nature is and how we, as part of it, can describe its peculiarities.

Specialized in contemporary music for soloist, chamber, ensemble music and sound arts, she is studying Master in Contemporary Percussion with Brian Archinal at the Hochschule der Künste Bern.

She has been finalist in numerous competitions, as the Juventudes Musicales de España (Madrid) and the Berlin Price for Young Artists, what has brought her the opportunity to record and play solo pieces in important venues around Europe, as the Elbphilharmonie (Hamburg) and Musikbrauerei (Berlin).

She has worked closely with composers such as Michael Maierhof, Simon Steen-Andersen, João Carlos Pinto and Helena Cánovas, discussing their pieces and doing studio recordings with some of them, and has worked with ensembles and chamber groups such as the Nouvelle Ensemble Contemporain, Vertigo Ensemble, ICE3 Ensemble, Aléoç Duo, Input Duo.. thus consolidating an extensive experience in chamber music and large ensembles.
